What is Required to Obtain This Scholarship?

To be eligible a candidate must:

- a) complete and submit an application form by May 28, 2006
- b) be of Jamaican heritage
- c) be between the ages of 16 to 24 years by July 1, 2006
- d) be accepted by, or already a degree seeking student in a college
- e) have a grade point average of at least 3.25
- f) Submit a one page, double spaced typed explanation of how your Jamaican heritage has helped you / will help you become successful in the United States
- g) be willing to show documentary proof of your Jamaican heritage to the scholarship committee.

Please submit documentary proof of age (e.g. birth certificate) and documentary proof of grade point average. If you are already pursuing a college major, please send a copy of your transcript. If not, submit a letter of acceptance. Do not send originals.
